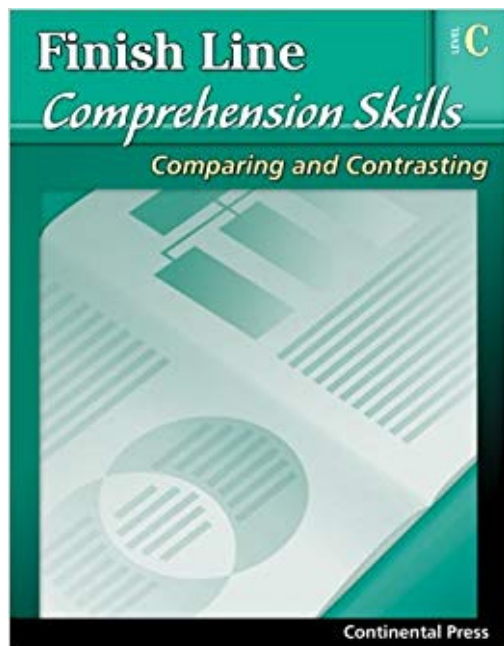


Reading Comprehension Workbook: Finish Line Comprehension Skills: Comparing and Contrasting, Level C - 3rd Grade *by* Continental Press

Most of the passages have been written on a second- or third-grade level of difficulty.
