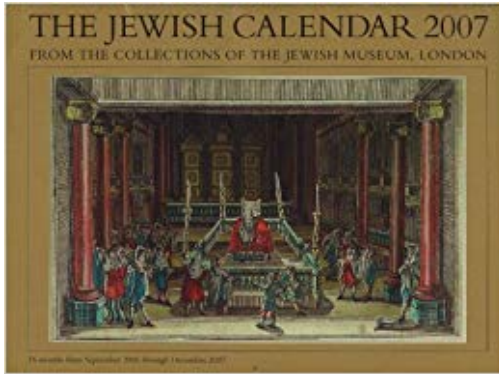

The Jewish Calendar 2007, now in its twenty-second year of publication, features spectacular images from The Jewish Museum of London. The museum's collections, the finest in the world, explore many aspects of Jewish life from medieval times to the present day. Forty-eight full-color illustrations of Judaic ceremonial and historical masterpieces are beautifully reproduced in this lovely calendar, which spans 16 months, from September 2006 to December 2007. It includes all national and Jewish holidays, as well as Sabbath candle-lighting times, weekly Torah portions, a list of Jewish holidays through the year 2011, and four wallet-size calendars.

I've bought this calander for many years now. I love the artwork/photos and the explanations that go along with the art. The layout of the calander is very good too; there is plenty of room to write things in it.

The Jewish New Year starts in September and so does this calendar, which covers 16 instead of 12

months. This calendar is larger than other Jewish calendars I've seen, and its pages are sturdy, not flimsy. The calendar art is from the Museum's collection of Jewish ceremonial and cultural art, and except for February, each month has one full-page art feature plus 2 smaller ones within empty calendar boxes. It identifies all Jewish holidays as well as all national holidays. Weekly Torah portions and Shabbat and holiday candle-lighting times are noted. Four wallet calendars with the Jewish holidays are also included. While primarily of Jewish interest, the calendar is also appropriate for Gentile Christians (like myself) who note the timing of Jewish holidays for commemorative or typological significance.
